Preliminary remark. As of 1 January 2024, GMS has not received any direct income from work anymore. Up to and including January 2026, the GMS-chairman still did some private advisory work and donated the proceeds to GMS. However, due to a recent health-issue, the GMS-chairman has decided to also stop doing such private advisory work as of February 2026.

On 28 April 2026 there was a monthly **deficit** ad \$ **462.-**. The deficit will be debited to the General Fighting fund. The 'base-line' (general reserve-fund) remains at \$ 10,000.-.

There are now 5 court cases pending funded by GMS, *three* in 2025 and *two* in 2026 (two about industrial accidents and one about the granting of Dutch nationality in 2025; one about eligibility for an AOV-benefit for the spouse of a pensioner in March 2026 and one about the principle that the Custody Board cannot give a second opinion about its own recommendation - another independent body or person must be appointed for the second opinion – in April 2026). One of the industrial accident cases of 2025 is a civil lawsuit. As noted before, this lawsuit was going to cost GMS considerably more than most GMS-funded cases. Fortunately, there is a positive development in this case. We expect more concrete info about this in May. Also in April 2026 an appeal was lodged in the other industrial accident case (see 23rd GMS Court Case).

There is still another case pending about 'social benefit to raise the Old Age Pension ('AOV') for some pensioners'. We had hopes that this case would end in an amicable settlement. That is not the case. We expect that the case will go to Court in May or June 2026. Another pending case has to do with the disproportional consequences of a so-called 'residence-gap' for immigrants. The IND (immigration office) has been contacted in an effort to reach a settlement. We have received word now that the IND will not settle this case. So, we are now preparing to take this case to Court. This is expected in June or July. Will update a.s.a.p.

Together with the Art-School/Art Gallery 'Sobremesa', GMS is organizing a public Art-Auction on 16 May of this year. GMS's own art-works (bought from local artists during the past 10 years) will be sold, but also approx. 20 new artworks produced and donated by local artists. This initiative has great potential for permanent yearly funds-raising for GMS. More details later.

The electricity bills for the months of January thr. April 2026 were paid direct by GMS to the owner of the building. This will now always be done in this way. So, there are no reimbursements to the GMS-Chairman for these payments anymore.

Bank-Balance as at 28 April 2026 was: **\$ 40,026.-**. Bank-balance as at end March 2026 was **\$ 40,488.-** → Monthly *deficit* for April amounted to \$ 462.-.

Note. There is only one sub-tenant now. So, we only have to reserve \$ 250.- for possible repayment for when the remaining sub-tenant might end the rental agreement.

Note 2. We have been reserving \$ 1,400.- for Provision for Court Costs in the ASOTEKO-case (see 14th GMS Court Case). The Court Costs were never claimed and the claim has now expired. So, the provision for these Court Costs will now be added to the Gen. Fighting Fund.
